



Visit the city of Mayapan. Its name means "The Banner of the Maya." Through its architecture, you can observe the strong influence of Chichen Itzá, an example of which is the main building, also known as the Castle of Kukulkan, which is identical to the one at Chichen Itza but on a smaller scale.

Afterward, we will head to the cenotes in the village of Homún, which offer the extraordinary experience of swimming in their crystal-clear waters. The lushness and, above all, the beauty of the cenotes make them one of the best natural attractions in Yucatán. In the Santa Barbara tourist complex, we will visit 3 cenotes.

- Includes: transportation, certified guide, entrance tickets to the archaeological site and cenote, truck, and life jacket for the cenote.
- Not included: food, beverages and tips

We recommend to bring comfortable clothing and shoes for climbing the buildings, water, a swimsuit, a towel, and sunscreen. Also, don't forget mosquito repellent.
